

MCS Elementary Reopening Plans

Arrival and Dismissal



- At-school hours will be from 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.
- All students will have their temperature checked upon arriving at the elementary school. No one with a temperature above 37.5 will be allowed to stay at school.
- Students should be dropped off in front of the elementary between 7:45-7:55 a.m. and follow their designated pathway to their classroom, enter one at a time, wait at each physical distance sticker for their turn, wash hands, then go to their assigned desk. - At 12:00 p.m. students will be called over the PA system to line up on the physical distance markers in the pavilion to take their turns entering their car or go directly to their parents if they are walking. Parents may not enter the elementary building during this time.

School Classroom



- Desks and physical distancing floor markers are spaced 1.5 meters apart to accommodate all students in the classrooms.
- The school will maintain a high level of cleaning and sanitization using a CDC-recommended solution.
- Windows and doors will be opened to ensure good ventilation.
- Students will be given time during the day for a snack outdoors and physically distanced.
- PE and recess are not yet permitted by the government at this time.
- Chapel and specials classes will be offered online.

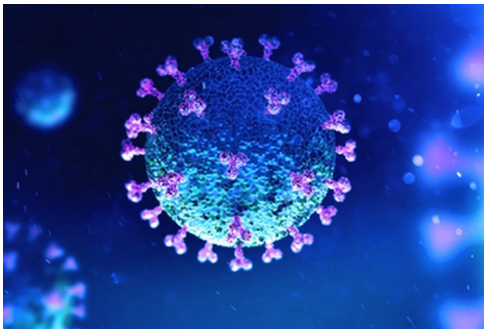
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Student Responsibilities



- Students and staff must wear a 3-ply cloth or surgical face mask at all times.
- Students should bring a healthy snack & enough water for 4 hours. (Water bottles can still be purchased for Rp 3,000 from the elementary office.)
- Students and staff will be trained in the health and safety protocol, such as washing hands regularly, keeping their masks on, physical distancing, etc.

COVID-19 Response



- The COVID-19 task force will meet regularly to monitor and assess the current school implementation and discuss improvements.
- The school principal along with the Leadership Team will meet to assess current conditions then communicate updates and recommendations to staff and families.
- If a student or staff member tests positive then those who have been identified as direct contacts will self-quarantine for 14 days and will need a negative PCR test to return to school.
