- Community run → for fun also, trail run with other schools the next morning



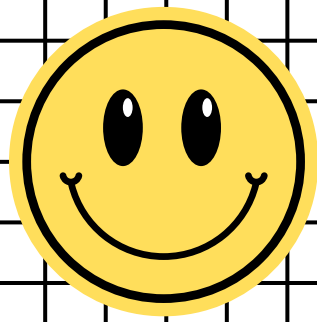
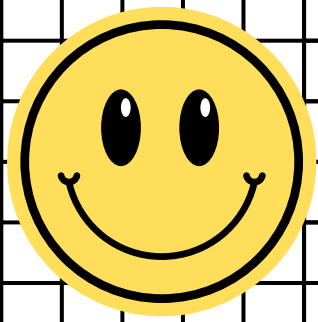
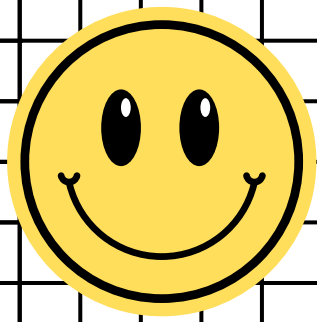
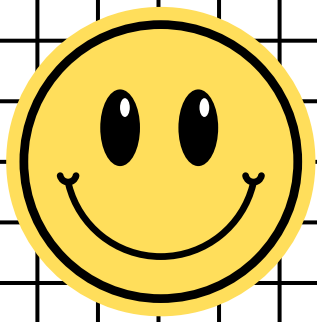
